

# MUD KILLER

## USER MANUAL

**Our device is not a toy! Not intended for use by children!**

Preparation to work:

Connect the "Mud Killer" device by a regular garden hose to the domestic water supply that has a pressure between 0.5 and 0.6 Bar.

- Do not use other installations with a higher water pressure (pressure washers, hydrants, etc.)
- Check if the distance between the coolers allows for a safe insertion of the cleaning lance between the coolers without a risk of damaging them.
- Adjust the pressure to make sure that it does not damage the delicate parts of the radiator.
- Provide a suitable place for cleaning the radiators - remember that there is a risk of soiling the surface on which the vehicle is standing with the washed out mud.
- If your coolers are additionally dirty with the oil or other substances, ensure that you have appropriately secured your working space to avoid a risk of polluting the environment.
- The paint surface is deliberately sensitive to scratches - thanks to this, you will pay attention to possible collisions in the space between the radiators and avoid bending of the lamellas.

The process of cleaning coolers

Pre-wash all the surfaces of the coolers - if they are covered with dried mud, you must first moisten them well - depending on the degree of the dirt this stage may require several repetitions.

After soaking the dirty coolers, start washing / rinsing - the rinsing time will depend on the degree of soiling - you can see the course of this process on our website: [www.mudkiller.eu](http://www.mudkiller.eu)

After finishing the work, remember to dry the device - unscrew the quick connector 3/4 " and place the attachment vertically to prevent water retention.

There is a possibility of the copper oxide to appear on the nozzle - for the device to work effectively, it must be cleaned off.
